MCT ReMan Ltd (MCT) is an environmentally conscious Company and as such we acknowledge the potential environmental impact that our operations may have on the environment and have adopted this International Standard to demonstrate MCT's commitment to prevent Pollution and protect the Environment.

The scope of MCT's Products and Services are:

**The manufacture, remanufacture and modification of Automotive and Non automotive driveline assemblies including engines, transmissions and final drive assemblies and sourcing and supply of Component Parts**

Top management endorses this policy and ensures it is compatible with the context and strategic direction of the Company. Senior management in co-ordination with the Environmental Compliance Manager are accountable for the effectiveness of the Environmental Management System (EMS) and are responsible for ensuring that it is communicated, understood, implemented and maintained at all levels within the Company, and ultimately that it achieves its intended outcomes, in the following manner:

- 4) MCT strives to integrate the EMS into all its business processes and shall provide its employees with the EMS resources, direction, support and encouragement required to fulfil their roles.
- 5) MCT strives to use natural resources, such energy, water and materials as efficiently as possible. MCT also strives to minimise waste to Landfill by segregating and recycling waste as much as is reasonably practicable.
